-  Regularly purchase reusable and durable products and recycled products whenever possible.
-  Recycle pallets, batteries, light bulbs and cardboard.
-  Provide recycle bins for our guests as requested.
-  Donate back to the city of Worcester old “durables” such as furniture.
-  Use paper products that are bleached without chlorine, and made with at least the minimum of acceptable post-consumer recycled content whenever possible.
-  Use refillable dispensers for soaps and cleaning products when possible.
-  Use programmable thermostats, dimmers on lights, motion detectors for lights in restrooms, and use natural lighting whenever possible. Fluorescent light bulbs have been upgraded to either T12 or T8.
-  Use environmentally preferable (green) cleaning products and low volatile organic compound products such as paint, adhesives, carpeting, air fresheners, etc. whenever possible.
-  Offer pitchers of water instead of pre-poured water glasses for meals.
-  Use cloth rather than paper table drapes for display tables.
-  Offer beverages served from dispensers rather than individual containers.
-  Offer the use of china and glass for meals and meetings rather than styrofoam or plastic.
-  Purchase locally grown produce, sustainable fish and fresh products rather than packaged whenever possible.
-  Donate leftover food to a local non-profit organization whenever possible.
-  Active participant in the Energy Star program.
